
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



Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions

Article 5.17 - Boats, Campers and Other Vehicles

Trailers, mobile homes, trucks larger than standard pickups, boats, tractors, campers, garden or maintenance equipment and vehicles other than automobiles, when not in actual use, shall be kept at all times in an enclosed structure or screened from public view and at no time shall any of said vehicles or equipment be parked or stored on a public or private right-of-way within the Property. No operative vehicle shall be parked or stored for a period in excess of seventy-two (72) consecutive hours on any portion of a Lot between the front of a Building and the abutting public right-of-way.

RV/utility trailer/camper or other vehicles/equipment stored in public view

Article 5.13 (d) - Refuse and Containers

All trash, debris, garbage and refuse shall be kept at all times in a covered container and all such containers shall be kept on a Lot within an enclosed structure or screened from public view.

Article 5.26 (c) - Fences

All fences and walls shall be constructed and installed and maintained in good appearance and condition at the expense of the Owner of the Lot on which they are located and all damaged fencing and walls shall be repaired or replaced to original design, materials and color within a reasonable time after said damage occurs.

Article 5.13 (a) - Lot Maintenance

Each Owner of a Lot shall maintain all Improvements located thereon in good and sufficient repair and shall keep the improvements thereon painted or stained, lawns cut, shrubbery trimmed, windows glazed, rubbish and debris removed, weeds cut and otherwise maintain the same in a neat and aesthetically pleasing condition.
